4. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Financial Comptroller General Office, Anamnagar by hand before 12 PM on 2077/06/15. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
5. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 1 PM, 2077/06/15 at the office of Financial Comptroller General Office, Anamnagar. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to a minimum of NRs. 96,500 which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
6. If the last date of purchasing and/or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
